SOLAPUR UNIVERSITY, SOLAPUR **Prospectus for the M. Phil Course 2016-17**

The M. Phil course of the Solapur University is a **regular full time course**.

Eligibility:

1. A candidate who holds the Master's degree with minimum second class with B+ in the faculties of Arts, Social Sciences, Science, Commerce and Education of this University or an examination of any other statutory University, recognized as equivalent there to, shall be eligible for admission to the M.Phil. course in the relevant faculty.
2. The students from other University shall apply for eligibility certificate before 2nd September by paying necessary fees alongwith the migration, degree certificates, statement of marks in original & xeroxed, attested copy (upto September 18, with late fee).

Admission :

A candidate seeking admission to the M.Phil. course in the University departments or in the affiliated colleges, shall have to appear and pass the entrance test (written & oral) in the relevant subject which will be conducted by the University. The entrance test (written) will be conducted in August every year and on the very next day oral will be conducted. The entrance test will test the student's knowledge of the subject and research aptitude. 50% weightage will be given to the marks obtained at P.G. level & 50 % for entrance test. After the entrance test, the admissions will be given in order of preference as below.

1. Of the total seats available, preference will be given to U.G.C. teacher fellows working in the Colleges affiliated to this University or working in the university department/School and the remaining 50% will be for M.A./M.Sc./ M.Ed./ M.Com. of this University on the basis of the merit in the entrance test.
2. If the seats remain vacant they will be filled up by:
 - a) teachers from the colleges affiliated to Solapur University on the basis of merit.
 - b) teachers and students from other Universities on the basis of merit.

Fees for the entrance test is Rs.300/- in cash or by a D.D. drawn in favour of The Finance and Accounts Officer, Solapur University, Solapur.

Reservation of seats will be as per the rules of the Government of Maharashtra.

Duration :

Duration of the course shall be two terms for theory course plus two terms for dissertation extendable by further two terms on request and on payment of the due fees. NO EXTENSION SHALL BE GIVEN BEYOND THREE YEARS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Registration :

A candidate duly admitted for the course shall submit purchase prescribed proposal form before 31st October and submit the same through the H.O.D/Principal of the College to the university office latest by 10th November.

The students shall have to submit their dissertation on the same title, which is approved by the university authorities.

Dissertation :

- A candidate must complete the whole course within a period of two years from the date of registration, extendable by two terms on payment of Rs.1,500/- per term only on application to that effect being presented to the university well in advance but in any case before the completion of the second year.
 - A candidate passing the theory examination at the first attempt shall submit his dissertation within a period of one year without paying additional fees.
 - A candidate passing theory examination in a subsequent attempt shall submit his dissertation within a period of two terms thereafter by paying an additional fee of Rs.1,500/- per term.
- The dissertation of a candidate will be accepted only after he/she passes in all the theory papers.
- The candidates in the faculties of Social Sciences and Education are allowed to write their dissertations in Marathi provided it is certified by the guide and recommended by the H.O.D./Principal/Dean.
- The candidates permitted to write the dissertations in Marathi shall have to submit the abstract in English also.
- The candidate shall have to get confirmed the title of his dissertation from the University office six months before the submission of dissertation and apply for change in title, if any, immediately stating the reasons for change, with the recommendations of the guide.
- A candidate submitting dissertation for the M.Phil. is required to follow the rules noted below regarding the size, style and binding of thesis, except in special case in which the head of institute of satisfied that it will not be possible to comply with the requirement of these rules.
- Size of the paper - Quarto approx. A-4 (25cmx20cm) except for drawings, graphs and maps on which no restriction is placed. A margin of 5 cm to be left on the left hand side and 1.5 cm on the right hand side and bound in a standard form. Top and bottom margins of approximately 3 cm be left.

8. Dissertation shall be typed on both the sides of a paper with 1½ spaces (cover page in the format of annexure-II).
9. The declarations by the guide and the students be added appropriately.
10. A candidate for M.Phil. degree shall initially submit to typewritten or printed copies alongwith CD/Electronics form of his/her thesis embodying the results of his/her research and stating with the work is best on the discovery of new facts by the candidate or of new relation of facts observed other and how the work tends to the general advancement of knowledge. The dissertation shall be written in English. However the when the subject matter of the thesis related to us modern European or Indian languages it may, with the prior permission of the Research and Recognition Committee be written in that language.
11. A candidate shall make the final submission of the dissertation in one copy before incorporating charges/modification/suggestion/comments as recommended the referees, to the university authority alongwith corresponding soft copy in case, candidate/guide intends to have certified from the university, who can also by presenting additional copy, not more than two at the time of defence further, a student submitting his/her thesis in the subject relating to the social sciences, education, Physical Education may write his/her thesis in Marathi or English. A candidate desirous of doing research in Indian languages may do so and submit his/her thesis in languages concerned with prior permission of Research & Recognition Committee. However, synopsis shall be submit in English

Viva :

The Viva-voce of all the M.Phil. students will be conducted in the University department only. The student shall attend the viva at his own cost. The student shall collect copy of dissertation immediately after the viva from university office. If the student fails to collect the same it will be sent to the concerned department for departmental library.

Detailed syllabus, rules and regulations prescribed for the M.Phil. course are available separately on payment of its price in the University office.

For all purposes of M. Phil course the term shall be counted from 1st July every year irrespective of the date of admission.
