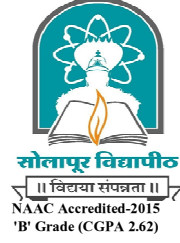

M.A. Entrance Examination

Admission Rules

Any graduate of any faculty (Other than B. A.) of this University or its equivalent

Conditions :

1. The Entrance Examination will be held by the University at Solapur Centre only. The eligible candidates shall have to apply for the Entrance Examination as per the University Advertisement of External.
2. The Entrance Examination will be held on or round as per the advertisement of External.
3. The application form shall have to submit directly to the university along with the examination fee mentioned in advertisement which is available on University website under link **Examination>External Department**.
4. The question-paper for each subject will carry 100 marks and will be 3 hours duration.
5. Candidates securing not less than 40% of marks in the Entrance Examination will be held eligible to take admission to the M. A. course in the subject.
6. A Candidate, intending to appear for the M. A. examination externally after passing the Entrance Examination shall have to register his/her name with the University before the prescribed dates.
7. i) A Candidate, passing the Entrance Examination in a subject, shall be allowed only to offer the same subject at his/her M. A. Examination.
ii) if a candidate desirous to appear for the M. A. Examination with change in subject he/ she is required to pass the M.A. Entrance Examination in that particular subject again and then only he/she can avail the facility of Regulation M. A., 6.

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- iii) A candidate shall have to offer only one subject for the Entrance examination.
8. A Candidate will have to option of answering questions in any of the subjects other than Languages, either in Marathi or in English.
 9. A Candidate, who desires to appear for M. A. Examination externally after passing the Entrance Examination, is required to satisfy the rules and conditions laid down for external registration.
 10. A candidate, who desires to appear for the M. A. examination externally, shall have to select to only those subjects for which teaching is provided for the regular students of this university and for which practical work is not required.
 11. A Candidate, who has passed B.Com. examination, need not to give the Entrance Examination for admission to the M. A. Economics subject only.
 12. A candidate is abide by these conditions as well as the instruction given in the enclosed prescribed form.
